Investment Rationale and Objectives

OCP Senior Credit Fund provides Unitholders with exposure to the performance of an actively managed, diversified portfolio comprised primarily of first lien floating rate senior secured loans of non-investment grade North American issuers.

The Fund's objectives are: (i) provide Unitholders with attractive, quarterly, tax-advantaged distributions, currently targeted to be \$0.50 per annum, representing an annual yield of 5% based on the original issue price of \$10.00 per Unit; (ii) preserve capital; and (iii) generate enhanced returns through increasing cash flow to the portfolio as interest rates rise.

Commentary

Net performance of OCP Senior Credit Fund was 0.72% and 12.65% in October and year-to-date, respectively. Investors digested mixed news including favorable housing and GDP reports, and generally disappointing third quarter earnings. The underpinnings of the high yield credit markets — stable U.S. economic growth, low default rates, and strong new issue markets — remained solid helping them outperform equities. The CS Leveraged Loan and CS High Yield Bond Indexes returned 0.37% and 0.86%, respectively, while the S&P500 lost 1.85%.

Although no position was a significant gainer or loser, the vast majority of the Fund's senior secured loans contributed to performance in the month. Gains in positions were primarily driven by interest income versus price appreciation. During the month we added exposure to several existing and new senior secured loans. There continued to be no unanticipated defaults in the portfolio and we believe its holdings will perform as expected.
